OCT SCANS

Modern technology means that your optometrist can now use a special machine to take not just photographs, but also 3D scans of the back layers of your eyes. This allows us to see any abnormalities very easily and provide a permanent record of the condition of your eyes. This is especially useful if you have macular degeneration, glaucoma, diabetes or have a family history of these conditions. The earlier we spot issues, the more likely it is that they can be treated.



The process itself doesn't hurt but just involves looking into a machine while the OCT scan is taken, which finishes with a bright camera flash. Once the scans are taken, you will be able to see the results and talk them through with our optometrists Gareth and Coraley. The scan is private as the NHS do not currently fund it. If Gareth or Coraley recommend it to you and you are eligible for an NHS sight test, you can pay an upgrade fee to have it included. If you are a private patient the scan is included in the premium examination fee. If you are unsure whether you would benefit from this scan, please talk with your optometrist on the day of your sight test.

ACUTE COMMUNITY EYE-CARE SERVICE ACES

What is ACES?

ACES is a **free** service available to all patients registered with a Somerset GP. The service provides patients experiencing recently occurring medical eye conditions with appropriate treatment closer to home. The service is provided by local optometrists with the specialist knowledge and skills to carry out this work at locally approved opticians.

The service is designed for recently occurring medical conditions such as:

- Sudden or recent reduction in vision in one or both eyes
- Red eye(s) or eye lids
- Pain and/or discomfort in the eyes, around the eye area or temples
- Recent onset or sudden increase of flashes and/or floaters in one or both eyes
- Mild trauma, for example a scratch to the outer surface of the eye(s) or lid(s)
- Suspected foreign body in the eye
- Recent onset of double vision
- Significant recent discharge from or watering of the eye

If you are unsure whether your symptoms qualify, please contact an ACES provider who can advise you.
